STAP cells

A Japanese-U.S. research team succeeded in producing pluripotent cells just by immersing somatic cells in mild acidic solution. The so-called stimulus-triggered acquisition of pluripotency (STAP) cells can also be produced simply by applying physical stimulus to cells such as passing them through a thin tube.

The researchers have thus far only succeeded in producing STAP cells by using the cells of mice, but if such pluripotent cells can be produced from human cells, they may be of greater value than induced pluripotent stem (iPS) cells. The discovery is expected to contribute to understanding the mechanism of life. The latest success should be nurtured as a breakthrough in regenerative medicine.

STAP cells can be produced much more easily, quickly and efficiently. Furthermore, STAP cells are believed to have a lower risk of turning carcinogenic than ES and iPS cells. If the research on STAP cells steadily progresses, the technology could be used to easily produce pluripotent cells of each individual. It is understandable that experts are placing high expectations on the technology.
