Missing Plane

On March 8th, the Malaysian air plane 370 from Kuala Lumpur to Beijing, China stopped being heard from over the South China Sea. The airplane's contact broke off one or two hours after it took off. The airplane was to arrive at 6:30 a.m. that day. There were 239 people in it. Some people think it was destroyed by terrorists. Others think there was a rapid stall by a sudden explosion or some troubles with its instrument. Many countries are trying to find out the truth, but they can't. Japan also dispatched the Self Defense Forces to solve this problem. I hope this problem will be solved and people in the airplane will survive this crisis. ---K.M

Depletion of the Ozone Layer

On March 9, a treatise on depletion of the ozone layer was announced in "Nature Geoscience," a British science magazine. This treatise shows that Four gases were newly discovered as toxic substances against the ozone layer. Three of the four gases are kinds of CFC(chlorofluorocarbon), and one of the four is a kind of HCFC (hydrochlorofluorocarbon). All the four gases do harm to the ozone layer, and they are all made artificially.

However, producing such gases is prohibited by the Montreal Protocol. So these gases can't be discovered. Now, the research team has no idea where these gases were produced. According to the research team's surmise, these gases may be related to the production of insecticides or coolants. In the treatise, it is said that the amount of these gases is so small that we don't have to pay attention to it. But recently, even at the North Pole, the ozone hole has been discovered for the first time. The more the depletion of the ozone layer progresses, the more likely it is that people suffer such disease as a cataract and skin cancer. I want the research team to find out where these gases are produced. Also, we have to think about the importance of the ozone layer again before it's too late. ---Y.K.
